An Austin Peay State University Occupational Safety and Health Policy has been established in accordance with policy guidelines set down by the State Board of Regents. The policy seeks to assure safe and healthy working conditions for the total University community. The Occupational Safety and Health standards for the State of Tennessee are adopted as the minimum safety and health standards for Austin Peay State University.

Administrative officials, departmental chairpersons, deans, directors, and supervisors are responsible for ensuring compliance with this policy.

The Vice President for Administration and Development is responsible for the development and publication of procedures necessary to administer the Occupational Safety and Health program. The Director of Physical Plant, under the general supervision of the Vice President for Administration and Development, is designated coordinator for campus programs.
