All administrative aspects of the University are organized under the President who is directly responsible to the Tennessee Board of Regents. The following officers are directly responsible to the President:

- Director of Affirmative Action**
- Director of Athletics**
- Executive Director of Human Resources**
- Executive Director of Marketing and Public Relations**
- Executive Director of University Advancement**
- Director of Internal Audit**
- Vice President for Academic Affairs**
- Vice President for Finance and Administration**
- Vice President for Student Affairs**

In addition, certain standing committees and the University Assembly serve in an advisory role to the President. The accompanying chart depicts the organizational structure for all administrative affairs of the University.
