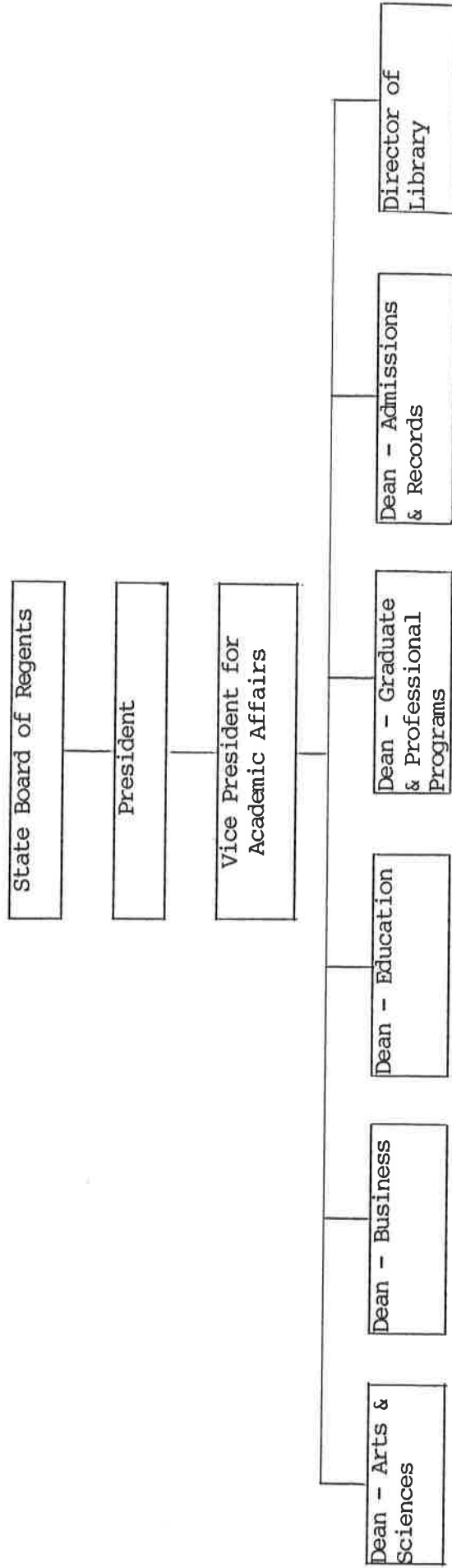
- Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences

- Director of the Library

Departments or divisions under these offices have a department chairperson or director who is responsible for the immediate operations of the department or division.

Academic, curricular and budgetary affairs associated with the principal offices and their departments or divisions all come under the general supervision of the Vice President for Academic Affairs.
