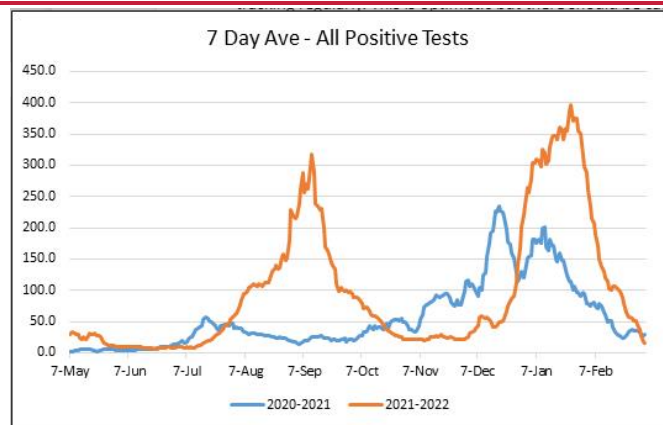

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ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Beginning April 4, 2022 Covid-19 testing facilities are no longer required to report negative Covid-19 results for tests authorized for use under a CLIA certification of waiver. This includes all rapid and antigen testing performed at schools, correctional facilities, employee testing programs, long-term facilities, rapid testing performed at pharmacies, medical provider offices, drive through and pop up testing sites. This is probably largely caused by the current inaccuracies with testing numbers due to the readily available antigen tests. We will no longer have true public positivity rates unless we look at only PCR testing in the public. The COVID-19 testing lab at APSU will still be required to report both positive and negative Covid-19 results.
