The Faculty Senate will meet this Thursday, November 11, at 3:00 p. m. in Room 139 of the Clement Building. All faculty are invited to attend Senate meetings.

The agenda for this meeting will consist of the following items:

1. The Executive Committee moves the approval of the following recommendation by the Faculty Benefits Committee regarding University policy relative to emeritus faculty:

To be eligible for standing as Austin Peay State University Emeritus Faculty, a person must have retired from Austin Peay State University after at least ten years of full time service at the University with faculty status. Generally, emeritus faculty would have the same privileges as teaching faculty on campus, including whatever new privileges might be forthcoming after retirement. Such privileges would carry the same kinds of responsibility expected from teaching faculty in return for those privileges. Furthermore, any specific list of rights and privileges must not be taken as restrictive; that is, any right or privilege not specifically listed is not to be denied emeritus faculty simply because it is not listed.

Emeritus faculty will continue to have faculty ID cards for whatever purposes such cards can be used, including the following:

The Felix G. Woodward Library and its facilities  
Faculty parking sticker free of charge upon request of emeritus faculty  
Tickets free of charge to University events (including athletic events) upon request of emeritus faculty  
Gymnasium facilities  
Participation in convocation and commencement exercises  
Office space if available  
Other University facilities (such as labs) if available and approved by appropriate persons (department chairperson, for example).

Notification should be made to emeritus faculty of this policy when it has been put together in a final form and approved by those persons in authority who approve such policies.
