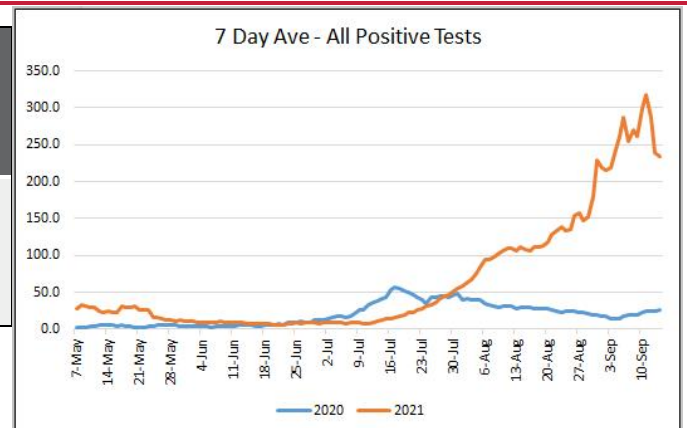

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- If we look at the surveillance of athletes, the vaccinated are no longer being tested, based on NCAA guidelines. That removes a small portion (unfortunately) of athletes. We had so many positive athletes from the second week of July until now, almost all who are unvaccinated are within a 90 day no testing window. When that 90 days is up, all the unvaccinated athletes will be back for screening. So, it's going to look like another surge in COVID-19 testing. – Dr. Phillips
- We will begin reporting the positivity rate of APSU testing next week. We are still working on a format that reflects the best, actionable information for you. Reporting the positivity rate will demonstrate what % of tests are positive no matter if 20 or 200 samples were collected. This is a way to standardize the value of test results.
