

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Numbers for 5/5/2022 reported through 4/30/2022. County Data is showing a moderate number of cases based on transmission in the community by our data. CDC data is indicating a marked increase in transmission. <sup>1</sup>The percentages of active cases and the 7 day average of positive cases and the total active cases are starting to show increases, but are now estimated as the State of Tennessee is no longer reporting active cases by county. There is a surge in cases nationally that started in the Northeast United States (see last figure, per CDC) this has now spread south and west and is creating high rates of transmission across the United States.
- Tests and reports on 5/2 were from samples taken from Wednesday 4/27 through 5/2. On 5/2 there were 13 samples collected; however, all samples and positives from that time period were reported on 5/2.
