UNAPPROVED MINUTES OF THE JANUARY 13, 1977 MEETING OF THE FACULTY SENATE

President Fott called the meeting to order. Fourteen senators were present; absent were Lambert, Thompson, Irwin, Jolly, Frazier, Mabry, Gannaway, Blanck, Larson. Fott read a letter from Dr. Sawrey concerning the change in academic calendar for next year which commended the faculty for its help in making the needed changes.
