

Unapproved Minutes of the September 25, 1980 Meeting of The Faculty Senate.

1. President Myers called the meeting to order at 3:05 p.m. The following Senators were absent: Thayer Beach, Olen Bryant, Camille Dillard, Willis Hackman, Phil Kemmerly, Ralph McCoy, John Matthews, Tom Patty, Pete Wenger, and Howard Winn.
2. It was moved for acceptance of the dates presented by President Myers for meetings of The Faculty Senate during the 1980-81 school year. The dates were October 16, November 13, December 4, January 22, February 19, March 26, April 23, and May 14. Motion seconded. Motion passed.
3. Moved that Richard Yarbrow be elected as a representative to The Faculty Sub-Council of The State Board of Regents. The motion was seconded. Motion passed.
4. President Myers appointed Pinckney as parliamentarian for the 1980-81 school year.
5. Motion made that The Faculty Senate Committees presented be accepted for the 1980-81 school year with the amendment that Pinckney be moved to the Academic Committee. Motion seconded. Motion passed.
6. Moved that the letter presented by Kanervo be mailed to Lewis Donelson with copies being sent to Riggs, Nix, Alexander and local state representatives. Motion seconded. Motion passed.
7. Moved that Kanervo write another letter to local newspapers and this letter be approved by The Executive Council of The Faculty Senate and mailed at the earliest date. Motion seconded. Motion passed.
8. President Myers charged The Academic Committee with the responsibility of investigating the Fort Campbell teaching operation and problems associated with it.
9. President Myers made announcements concerning future Senate business.
10. Meeting adjourned.
