

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Govs Back the Vax Challenge has seen 217 online participants from employees all showing vaccination cards and table event had 271 show up with 249 showing proof of vax. Total 466 participants! The link did not work for students, IT resolved the issue and a new link will go out this morning through GovSays.
- Numbers for 10/4/2021 reported as of 9/30/2021. Data at times is lagging over a week. Substantial changes occur well after the data is reported, and as far back as 2 weeks later. Further, death data is lagging and hospitalization data is grossly inaccurate. What's worse is that the number reported over the last 14 days in new positives is 1606 yet the total active cases reported for today is only 1209 this is impossible. This means the data is useful for trends

but is grossly underestimated. COVID-19 conditions are leveling off below peak but substantially higher than most of last year. –Dr. Scanlan
