The academic aspects of the University are organized under the Vice President for Academic Affairs, who is responsible directly to the President of the University. The following offices are responsible to the Vice President for Academic Affairs.

Assistant Vice President for Academic Affairs

Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences

Dean of the College of Business

Dean of the College of Education

Dean of the College of Graduate and Professional Programs

Director of Admissions

Director of the Library

Director of Records and Registration

Departments or units under these offices have a department chairperson or director who is responsible for the immediate operations of the department or unit.

The University operates a Center at Fort Campbell, supervised by a director, and a non-credit Continuing Education Program, both of which report to the Dean of the College of Graduate and Professional Programs.


Academic, curricular and budgetary affairs associated with the principal offices and their departments or units all come under the general supervision of the Vice President for Academic Affairs.
