- 1. The status of Research Associate is established:
  - a. To provide a suitable University professional address for bachelor-level graduates who are continuing research interest and activity developed at Austin Peay State University.
  - b. To provide a suitable tie with the University for people without an academic affiliation who have special skills and wish to be involved in the intellectual life of one of the departments; and
  - c. To more fully identify the University with its scholarly products.
- 2. Bachelor-level graduates of Austin Peay State University, in departments not having graduate programs, shall be eligible for appointment as Research Associates, provided that:
  - a. They are currently involved in a scholarly activity with an Austin Peay faculty member;
  - They can reasonably expect to author or co-author a scholarly paper or comparable work during the three years following their appointment; and
  - c. The appointment is without compensation from the University, except for the rights and privileges specified in this policy.
- 3. Other citizens shall be eligible for appointment as Research Associates provided that:

- a. They are involved in a departmentally approved scholarly activity with an Austin Peay faculty member or student;
- b. They can reasonably be expected to author or co-author a scholarly paper or comparable work during the three years following their appointment; and
- c. The appointment is without compensation from the University, except for the rights and privilege specified in this policy.
- 4. Appointments may be made by a dean of one of the four Colleges, upon recommendation of the appropriate department chairperson, for a period of three years.
- 5. Research Associates shall be entitled to the following rights and privileges:
  - a. Be listed as a Research Associate in the departmental section of the University Bulletin.
  - b. Use of the University Library and its facilities.
  - c. Faculty parking sticker.
  - d. Use of department equipment, subject to approval of chairperson and faculty supervision.
