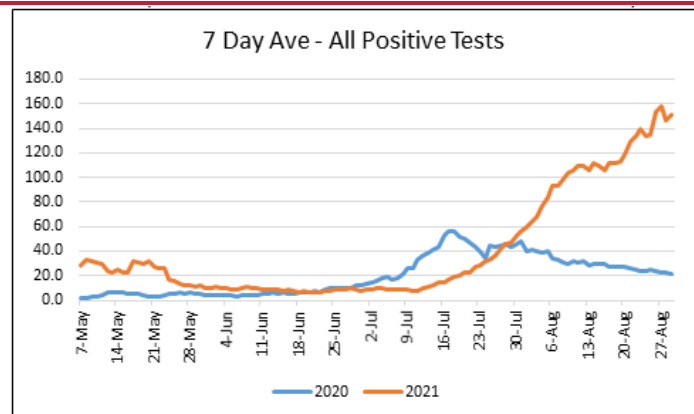

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- We have now doubled the highest number of + cases (57, 1/18/21) from last academic year.
- Testing lab positives are doubling roughly every 8-10 days. In the history of the lab, we have never had more than 40 people symptomatic/exposed per day. We are now in a new territory where surveillance is being put on the back burner because we have such a large volume of ill patients. – Dr. Phillips
- CMCSS: 701 student positives, 3,125 student exclusions, 76 employee positives, 154 employees on COVID leave. Tennova: 31 employees out (20 are positive). No visitation in ER (unless pediatric patient or they are primary care giver, or end of life). County Health: Have been focusing on vaccinations, but starting last week reduced vaccinations and increased testing. Prioritize the uninsured and impoverished and children. Test every weekday 8-10 with the priority people. Rest of day is for vaccinations.
