

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

• Numbers for 10/19/2021 reported as of 10/17/2021. The number of positive tests is getting ready to cross last year's fall/winter spike. While data is falling, there should be caution, as the percentage of positive tests has not continued the same decrease. An uptick in percent positive is usually a leading indicator for higher case numbers. This could be due to several factors. 1. Cases are leveling off and could increase. 2. People are not getting tested so the total number of cases appears down but in reality this number is due to less testing because only the sickest test positive. 3. Artifact between non-vaccinated testing and those who are vaccinated not testing regardless of symptoms.
