Approval of Minutes

Trustee McInnis stated that the minutes for the June 10, 2022, Student Affairs Committee meeting were circulated before the meeting. She asked if there were any corrections or additions to the minutes. There were none.

Trustee McInnis moved to approve the minutes as written. Trustee May seconded the motion. A voice vote was taken, and the motion carried unanimously with four trustees voting yes.

Action Items

A. Consideration of Revisions to the Student Trustee Selection Process

Trustee McInnis recognized Gregory Singleton who provided information about the revisions to the student trustee selection process. The primary change in the process is that the president will forward the application of one student for consideration to be appointed as student trustee. The Student Affairs Committee may vote to approve the recommended student or may ask for additional nominees. Singleton explained that the proposed process is better aligned with the processes used at the university to identify students for other student trustee or leadership positions.

Trustee McInnis moved to approve the Revisions to the Student Trustee Selection Process. Trustee Berg seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken and passed unanimously with four trustees voting yes.
