**UNAPPROVED MINUTES OF THE FEBRUARY 18, 1982  
MEETING OF THE FACULTY SENATE**

Members absent: Senators White, McMinn, Shain, Thompson, Dillard, Bryant, Carter, Joblin.

1. Vice-President Sears called the meeting to order at 3:05 p.m.

2. Minutes of January 21, 1982 meeting were approved.

3. Announcements:

a. President Riggs has referred the proposed TTh schedule to the Faculty Council.

b. The mandated 2 percent payroll cut has been decreased to 1 percent for Austin Peay.

4. Faculty Review of Administration:

a. Chair corrects report of ad hoc committee for evaluation of administration: Item 3 should specify return of forms by February 25.

b. Moved that report of the ad hoc committee for administration evaluation be accepted. Motion seconded and passed.

5. Report on Parking (Faculty White Committee): no report.

6. Report from SBR Faculty Sub Council: February 5 meeting considered, among others, these matters:

a. Tenure and Promotion Policy and its failure to require written reports at administrative level: SBR Counsel said Board prefers no written explanations in order to avoid difficulties in court.

b. Patents and copyrights document was recommended for consideration by Board of Regents.

c. Sub Council requests that its concern about less than adequate professional salaries be communicated to the Regents, Legislature and Governor.

d. Discussion of proposal to increase mathematics requirement to 9 hours.

e. Discussion of program changes in teacher education.

f. Discussion of SBR funded program in faculty development.
