2008 Annual Report: Honors and Awards Committee

Actions/Accomplishments:

The main actions of the Honors and Awards Committee are 1) overseeing the selection of the Drane and Harvill-Civitan Awards; 2) overseeing the selection of faculty awards (Distinguished Community Service, Distinguished Professor, and Hawkins Awards); and finally 3) organizing the annual Honors and Awards Ceremony held in late April of each academic year.

This year, all of the above-mentioned responsibilities were accomplished. The Honors and Awards Committee continued to work with Student Affairs for purchasing gifts for each academic unit (either statues or items selected by the department) to present with their most distinguished award, and supplemental money toward food and goodies for honor students. A change was also submitted to update the Honors & Awards introduction statement for the 2008-2009 undergraduate bulletins. For the second straight year, the Harvill-Civitan Award will be presented at Honors and Awards Day.

With the transition to Banner, there were many problems in obtaining the many lists required for determining eligibility for both academic honors and faculty awards. Meetings with representatives from the Registrar's Office helped, however corrections/improvements must still be made. Hopefully these issues will be resolved by next year. In addition, these discussions led to proposed changes in how Honors students are determined. Undergraduate students must maintain a 3.65 GPA and Graduate students must maintain a 3.85 GPA for the previous two regular semesters (summer term is not included), currently have full-time status, and must have completed at least 16 credit hours of coursework. It is hoped that these proposed changes will be followed next academic year.
