ENGAGE! seeks to pursue a vision that inspires and transforms the campus life experience, builds community and belongingness, supports a healthy well-being, and develops the division of tomorrow.

B. Dining Renovations

Trustee McInnis recognized Clemons to provide information about the dining renovations. As part of the 15-year agreement, Sodexo will renovate the Catherine Evans Harvill Hall bringing their latest vision of residential dining to our campus. These investments - part of Sodexo's "WOW" dining program developed specifically for Austin Peay, will support the institution in attracting and retaining students by promoting dining as a differentiator.
