UNAPPROVED MINUTES
OF THE FEBRUARY 15,
1979 MEETING OF
THE FACULTY SENATE

President Foote called the meeting to order at 3:10 p.m. Twenty-two senators were present; absent were Gannaway, Matthews, Hackman, Randall, Stokes, and Thomas. The minutes of the January 18, 1979 meeting were approved.

I. Announcements by President Foote

- A. Dr. Sawrey and Dr. Fred Williams will discuss at the next University Assembly meeting Dean's List qualifications and the APSU 5-year Plan, respectively.
- B. Actions on Amendments to Senate Constitution
 - Amendment #1 adding "counseling service" to list of eligible faculty to serve on Senate (Reference: April 6, 1978 minutes) (Ratfied by 101 for, 9 against, 10 abstained)
 - 2. Amendment #2 adding counseling center to the social sciences for senatorial selection purposes (Reference: April 6, 1978 minutes)
 (Ratified by 109 for, 8 against, 11 abstained)
 - 3. Amendment #3 dealing with eliminating May organizational meeting (Reference: April 6, 1978 minutes)
 (Ratified by 109 for, 1 against, 10 abstained)
 - 4. Amendment #4 dealing with allowing the Faculty Senate to amend its Constitution by a two-thirds majority of entire Senate. (Reference: December 7, 1978 minutes) (Not Ratified by 98 for, 12 against, 10 abstained.)
 - * 100 votes required for amendment ratification.
- II. Question-and-Answer Forum with President Riggs. A Vigorous discussion, lasting forty-five minutes, ranged over such topics as: budget deficits due to inflated fuel costs; athletic funding and the contribution of athletics to APSU university program; impounding of departmental equipment budgets; revisions in state funding formula.
- TTI. Dr. Winn's report (chairman of Faculty Committee) on Faculty Review of Administration was postponed until the March Faculty Senate Meeting.
