Trustee Mealer recognized Provost Cronley to provide information regarding the degree and certificate awards by type and academic year. APSU reached the highest ever number of degrees awarded in 2020-2021 in part due to a significant portion of undergraduate students choosing an associate degree as their primary objective, yet also earning a bachelor's degree. APSU has also experienced a 32% increase in master's degrees awarded during the five-year period.
