### Major Actions or Accomplishments:

- We trained 105 staff, faculty, and students in Overdose Prevention using Narcan and substance abuse resources.
- We developed ten partnerships for HIV/Substance use and safe sex prevention.
- Trained 320 program participants in risk management on AOD and consent skills.
- Hosted 3 Lunch-n-learn for students to discuss HIV prevention and how it correlates with substance use.
- Hosted Arrive Alive event with THSO and UNITE with a grant.
- Hosted 2 Take Back Drug Days events at sporting games (football and baseball).
- Showed a documentary film on the effects of substance use to 200 students.
