

Unapproved Minutes of the October 16, 1980 Faculty Senate Meeting

1. President Myers called the meeting to order. The following senators were absent: Camille Dillard, Arthur Eaves, Willis Hackman, Ralph McCoy, John Matthews, Tom Patty, Pete Wenger, Howard Winn, and Richard Yarbrow.
2. President Myers moved for approval of the minutes. Motion passed.
3. President Myers moved for approval of the agenda. Motion passed.
4. President Myers made the following announcements:
 - a. Dr. Hutchinson was elected to replace Charles White on The Faculty Senate.
 - b. An election is in progress to fill two vacancies on the Academic Council.
5. Discussion occurred on the changing length of the summer term. It was moved to refer this to Academic Committee. Motion passed.
6. Proposed changes in The Faculty Senate Constitution were presented. This item will be presented at the next Faculty Senate meeting.
7. President Myers announced that President Riggs stated that he would now allow faculty representation on the University Budget Committee.
8. It was moved that President Myers present a charge to the Library Committee before the next Faculty Senate meeting. Motion passed.
9. It was moved that the Academic Committee study Continuing Education offerings and make a report at the next meeting. Motion passed.
10. Dr. Foote's motions contained in the agenda were presented:
 - a. The motion concerning the length of student registration passed.
 - b. The motion concerning pay for the University Assembly President failed.
