

- Theatre and Dance have a cluster of positive cases in the last 4 days. The numbers should show
  up in tomorrow's data after HR processes the forms.
- It was officially announced New York City is in a COVID-19 outbreak. The variants are daughters of "Stealth Omicron," BA.2 The variants are BA 2.212 and BA 2.121. They do not have a name yet. In 3 days, these variants have made up 70% of the cases in New York. This virus is significantly more transmissible, with an R0 of 15! For perspective, BA 2 had an R0 of 12, and Omicron had an R0 of 8. All we can hope is we have enough background immunity, with warmer weather, and school letting out soon... we may be able to avoid a surge, but I am unsure at this point. Dr. Phillips
