## Committee Activity

The sustainable campus fee committee operated this year with an annual contribution of \$168,640.72 plus a carryover from the previous year's committee of 9,878 bringing our total budget to \$178,518.72. During this period there were a number of proposals brought before the committee totaling \$120,303 and leaving a balance brought forward of \$58,215.72.

## **Future Plans**

The committee voted to proceed with a project to install a solar parking canopy. At this time we are still awaiting a quote to determine the feasibility of this project. The committee voted to commit up to \$99,000 for this project, dipping into the long-term project funds. This project will be tabled to be voted on by next year's committee since the vendor has taken so long to submit cost information.

Several other projects were tabled to the following year due to lack of funds to support the project at this time: Brita water filter re-filling stations in housing and a proposal to revamp recycling on campus.
