## Major Actions or Accomplishments:

The main actions of the Honors and Awards Committee are 1) overseeing the selection of the Drane and Harvill-Civitan Awards; 2) overseeing the selection of faculty awards (Socrates, Distinguished Community Service, Distinguished Professor, and Hawkins Awards); and finally 3) organizing the annual Honors and Awards Ceremony held in late April of each academic year. This year, all of the above-mentioned responsibilities were accomplished.
