Medical and Hospitalization Insurance Requirements:

- 1. All foreign non-immigrant students are required to maintain medical and hospitalization insurance on themselves as a condition to their admission to Austin Peay and it must be maintained throughout their enrollment.
- 2. The student will be informed of this requirement via the admission acceptance correspondence or as soon thereafter as feasible in an easy to understand format.
- 3. To meet this requirement, one of two options must be selected:

Option #1:

The student will provide proof of "adequate" existing coverage in the form of a document from the insurer. Proof of coverage will include the following limits and conditions:

- a) Basic medical expenses benefit per illness/injury -\$5,000 Deductible per illness/injury - \$50 Daily room and board limit - cost of semi-private room
- b) Major medical expenses benefit \$45,000
- c) Catastrophic major medical expenses benefit -\$100,000

- d) Repatriation expenses benefit \$10,000
- e) Medical evacuation benefit \$3,000

Option #2:

If option #1 is not selected prior to registration, the student will automatically be enrolled in a group policy and the cost will be added to the costs for registration which will be paid at that time. A brochure describing the benefits and costs of the group policy will be made available to the student.

- 4. These requirements will be administered and coordinated by Student Health Services.
- 5. The effective date of implementation of these requirements will be January 1, 1990.
