Major Actions or Accomplishments:

Due to COVID restrictions, the Sexual Assault Programming Committee did not hold formal meetings throughout the 2020-2021 academic year. However, programming, outreach, and education still took place both in person, via zoom, and through online educational modules.

The following took place during the 2020-2021 academic year:

All incoming new freshman students were sent the Everfi Sexual Assault Prevention for Undergraduates and all incoming new graduate students were sent the Everfi Sexual Assault Prevention for Graduates modules in both the fall 2020 and spring 2021 semesters. The completion rates are as follows for the fall 2020 semester:

Undergraduate Students:

Part I Completed: 1139 Part II Completed: 779 Registered: 1297

Graduate Students:

Part I Completed: 41 Part II Completed: 51 Registered: 57

Additionally, during the spring 2021 semester, 391 new undergraduate and graduate students completed the Everfi modules. Since the platform has changed for the online course, completion rates are no longer delineated between parts 1 and II.

Additionally, during the 2020-2021 academic year, there were two (2) Upstander trainings conducted and five (5) Peer Educators were trained. Additionally, 24 students were trained in bystander intervention strategies, consent, and rape culture. There were a total of seven (7) bathroom poster campaigns and over 20 social media posts for our social marketing campaign. In collaboration with the Department of Women's and Gender Studies, we also participated with the promotion of both the Vagina Monologues and the Clothesline Project.

During Women's Empowerment Week, members of the Sexual Assault Programming Committee also participated in the "Breaking down the Stigma" panel held on March 1, 2021; the Women's Health Panel on March 3, 2021; and the "Empowered in the Workplace and Women Owed Business Fair" held on March 4, 2021.
