

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Montgomery County Unified Command reports 50 employees and 355 students positive at CMCSS, further, 87 employees and 2,199 students are quarantined. Tennova reports 34 beds (about half full) used in COVID unit. Highest surge for all of COVID was mid-60s, they hit half that in the last 10 days.
- The first APSU employee admitted to an ICU for COVID at BAC. She works in the CLC, Student Affairs leadership is aware.
- All Age Active cases on 8-21-2020 were 242 in Montgomery County; Active cases on 8-21-2021 are 1528. Cases are 6.5 times higher than last year on the same date. According to County data, our rate is 1.16 cases/10 people. Interpreting the data: if we have 10 students in each classroom we would potentially have 1 student that is positive in each class.
