

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Vaccination information comparing Montgomery County to the surrounding 946 counties in the nine-state area: 41.7% of the total pop. fully vaccinated is higher than 89.4% of other counties; 51.4% of Age 12+ fully vax is higher than 92.7% of other counties; 54.7% of the Age 18+ fully vaccinate is higher than 93.1% of other counties; 80.9% of the Age 65+ fully vaccinated is higher than 93.7% of other counties. Info from Joey Smith, County Health Dept.
- Current 7-day avg. shows some leveling off. I expect some slight decrease coming but this may increase as children return to school. Also, it feels like these numbers are decreasing due to appointment delays. Additionally, as places stop checking or requiring tests people are not testing or just waiting 5-10 days. Those will not appear in the numbers. – Dr. Scanlan
