The change to the policy includes adding an end date to salary increase incentive so that future enrollment would not automatically result in a salary increase. Harkey asked if there are other ways to make the change. Robinson stated that APSU is the only institution of the LGIs that provides resources for people to obtain degrees in addition to salary increases upon degree attainment. Roark confirmed this statement was correct. A discussion followed on the salary increase budget and salary comparisons. Robinson discussed comparators each institution uses to develop a salary compensation plan. Mitchell asked for clarification of eligibility. Harkey stated anyone beginning a program after January 1, 2021, will not be eligible for a salary increase upon degree attainment. Roark discussed tracking and compiling data for people enrolled in a degree program prior to January 1, 2021.
