University President's Report, President Michael Licari - 3:00 PM to 3:15 PM-

Dr. Licari thanks everyone. Spring always brings the state budget process. They came out favorable we are doing well in the performance funding formula. 13.4 or 13.7% we are receiving the largest % increase that any one is recommended to get. The hard work we are doing on campus is literally paying dividends. That was passed by the commission to the governor. One of which was talk about extra appropriations. That's what we did last year so we didn't have an increase. I am strongly in favor of that. It's great for our students so they don't have to suffer from additional price increase and if we can hold down tuition that's good for them. When we look at the data for why people leave APSU some just transfer out and some don't do well academically and need to be told to take some time off. Some leave because they can't afford to be there. Anything we can do helps. The other thing is the house on 2.15.23. A couple weeks to make sure were ready this is the remaining funding for the pre-professional health building. Good at the time the proposal was put together and quickly became unrealistic were back asking for an additional \$35 million to finish the building. Building a piece of the building is kind of pointless. We will be asking for this. We will see the governor state of the state address is coming up Monday evening. We will have a clearer picture soon. It's not a kiss of death we just need to do some work with our legislators to make sure we get on the same page with that. The SLT and I sat down with our state legislators. They are armed with the good news and good things we are doing here so they will know and have 20 minutes' worth of positive stories. Wanted them to understand our priorities and critical need. State budget process we will know more starting in February. The final touches of the strategic plan are just about ready to go live. Dannelle and Senator Bailey will start distributing them more widely. These are already pretty well vetted. Thank you to Kat and Dannelle for ensuring this all gets done in a way we feel good about. Stay tuned for that. In terms of planning we have a lot going on. Athletics and philanthropy are doing strategic plans. We are working on 10 year plans we are slated to expire soon and it's run its course it was great we were able to accomplish pretty much everything in the plan. It's time to start a new one so we will be establishing some working groups and all of that. A draft of the plan in front of the board of trustees by the December meeting. A lot more planning work it's all good work the campus master plan is important. You might think oh well whatever who cares but the state cares. They always check our master plan to see where this



proposal fits. We need to get 10 years of high-quality requests. It's a plan that will be worth hundreds of millions of dollars some good hard work this calendar year.

That's my report. The town halls will be February 15th and 16th. We've got two in the morning and two in the afternoon. First convo will be with president's cabinet look for my email at the beginning of next week. VP Fisher says can you talk about the time line for some of our bigger hires. It varies by committee I was still making some adjustments to the search committees. We are pretty well set. The CIO search is another one. We are early in the process as well. You can do them in a couple of weeks they take a couple of months. We should have those done and wrapped up within six months or so. Thank you all for your time. See ya Hannah! President Allen thanks him to be here as often as he is we really appreciate his time and we know where to find him.

Health Services – Crystal Henson – 3:15 PM to 3:30 PM- My name is Dr. Crystal Henson this will allow us to be a full survive lab. For staff what I have to offer you are resources. Anxiety depression grief etc. We don't provide counseling to staff. All of the same things you could do in an urgent care. Need a strep test covid test or flu test. We are starting to be able to bill insurance. It significantly decreases wait times. It's \$15 for you to meet with a practitioner but there is an additional charge if you leave with anything. Once we start billing insurance will turn into a million different amounts. What questions do you guys have? Do you know what insurance you accept- Senator Thompson asks? Cigna/blue cross/blue shield. I think tri care is the other insurance. We still are waiting on insurance. Also, Medicare. That will help some of our students who don't have access to insurance. Senator Bailey says from a planning standpoint you might not have an answer. I am thinking about you guys have always provided medications at cost the nearest pharmacy is pretty far. Do we have plans to make that broader? No, typically what we do what right now is goodrx. They can show you who has your medication at the lowest rate. Because of the wide range it wouldn't be cost effective. Most of them you need to buy them in a lot its not likely that the dispensary will get much larger. We have so many students who don't have insurance or they have plans they don't want to use. We've been using goodrx to tell people where to go. Can you tell us how we are billed for services asks Hannah? Yes, it is billed into your account or you will get a bill in the mail and it gets paid through the business office. You are super easy thank you.

Be Fit Be Well Be a Gov – Fonda Fields – 3:30 PM to 3:40 PM- Fonda could not be there today. This is her baby and she's been working really hard for several months now. This is definitely a larger expanded campus initiative. Be fit, be well, be a gov. A collection of campus wide initiatives. This brings all employees together in meaningful ways. Employees can get involved and lead future initiatives. You can see how to be connected and be energy focused. This is just about being healthy and being good. They do have to have specific listings. Any other? Perry says can you clarify this policy? She says they combined two policies together. The title 9 person has always been in HR but then LaNeeca Williams is also the title 9 coordinator and it used to be Sheila. Senator Bailey says it's a good time to note they have relocated. Now their offices are in Browning. If you are on the main floor you can't miss this office. They went where the accounting folks used to be.
