**Major Actions or Accomplishments:**

Name of Initiative	Cost	Brief Description
Recycling Bins for New Buildings	\$2,500	Four sets of the standard campus recycling bins for new buildings.
Living Green LLC Budget	\$1,000	Allocates funds for this first year living community hosted by the sustainability office.
Great Green Idea Contest Prize	\$600	Funded the annual contest prizes.
Marks Water Refill Station	\$500	Retrofitted an existing drinking fountain with a bottle refill station for the tutoring center.
MUC Water Refill Stations	\$1,500	Retrofitted three existing drinking fountains with bottle refill stations.
"Fill It Yourself" Reusable Water Bottle Initiative	\$6,000	Reusable water bottles for every Freshman at convocation, 10 five-gallon catering style water dispensers, and 5 ten-gallon insulated water dispensers to offer free ice water for programs and to encourage a campus culture of reusable bottles.
Recycled Shirt Pilot	\$500	Subsidized the cost of 100% recycled cotton shirts for Plant the Campus Red.
Recycled Shirt Subsidy Program for '22-'23	\$5,000	Subsidized the cost of 100% recycled cotton shirts for campus organizations.
Sustainable Menstrual Hygiene	\$500	Purchased reusable menstrual hygiene products for student education.
Composting Toilet for OEC	\$2,300	Composting ADA Compliant Restroom at APSU Outdoor Education Center. Would support student and community guests.

Total annual allocations totaled: \$20,400

The following routine budget allowances were voted in perpetuity to guarantee future support for the following:

Name of Initiative	Cost	Brief Description
Great Green Idea Contest	\$600	Annual competition to solicit student ideas for sustainability. Prizes awarded to top three ideas as judged by members of the SCFC.
Sustainability Student Worker Wages	\$5,000	This allows for 2-3 part time student workers dedicated to sustainability. They focus on supporting the fill it yourself initiative, campus recycling, programming, football game day recycling, etc.
Living Green LLC Budget	\$1,000	Allocates funds for this first year living community hosted by the sustainability office. Expected costs include meals, programming, and transportation.
