October 3, 2018 APSURA Board Meeting Minutes

Jim displayed a colorful placard that has attracted attention to our table in the past. Jim has compiled new application forms to be placed on the table at the Benefits Fair.

Sharon announced that the luncheon will be held Tuesday, October 30, at First Baptist Church at 11:30. It will be a buffet, and the price is \$18 per person. The room holds 50 people, and the church does the catering. Sharon suggested we charge \$15 and get Mitch to cover the additional \$3 per person. At the Looking Glass, we paid \$22 for members and \$20 for non-members.

Cheryl suggested we use the luncheon as a recruiting opportunity.

We voted to charge \$15 for the luncheon and to use it as our Connections program for October instead of an evening Connections program.

Jim said he will meet with the leadership of Advancement and inform them about APSURA. Jim will also emcee STAR this year.

On November 27, Cindy Marsh will have our Connections program at our usual time and place. Since some of our members are not comfortable driving at night, it was suggested that we contact people who would not ordinarily come because of the nighttime driving and offer to pick them up.
