2. Approval of minutes from the October 4th meeting

Old Business – Second Reading:

3. 4:026 Cash and Gift Card Payments (revised)

Harrison moved to approve the policy for the second reading and to move it to the President for approval. Cronley seconded the motion.

Discussion:

The committee discussed feedback from the public comment period regarding reducing the threshold for receiving a check or direct deposit instead of a gift card for payment. The committee determined that the change was unnecessary since the paperwork required for both payment methods is the same.

New Business – First Reading:

4. 5:020 Leave Policies (revised)

Cronley moved to approved the policy for the first reading and to be moved to the second reading. Scanlan seconded the motion.

Discussion:

Robinson discussed revisions to the policy to clarify the use of annual leave and revisions that removed the two (2) day limit for sick leave after bereavement leave has been used for immediate family and expanded the use of sick leave in the death of non-immediate relatives. The committee made additional revisions to clarify that employees may not use annual leave during the last ten working days of the employee's resignation notice period unless with supervisor approval. This policy revision does not apply to retirement.

The committee approved the policy for the first reading and to be moved to the second reading.
