Architectural Notes The original 1850's structure was probably an L-shaped intersection of two gables. W.A. Settle has been shown to have purchased the property in 1870 from J. A. Wendell. We assume that Mr. Settle built the newer parts of the house as bricks have been found there bearing his name.
