

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- The state has not released data in 11 days.
- Testing numbers at the APSU lab are lower these days because so many have been eliminated from PCR testing due to a positive test in the last 90 days. This could be troubling when new variants (Omicron BA.2) take off in Montgomery County. We should encourage folks to test using antigen test 2-3 weeks later if they have symptoms, because it may be another variant.
