



UNAPPROVED MINUTES OF THE MARCH 25, 1982 MEETING OF THE FACULTY SENATE.

Members absent: Senators White, Shain, Miller, McMahan, McCoy, Golden, Wallace.

- 1. President Carter called the meeting to order at 3:05 p.m.
- 2. Minutes of the February 18, 1982 meeting were approved.
- 3. Agenda was approved with the addition of an additional item, "Merit Pay."
- 4. University President Robert O. Riggs, reporting on positive developments, made the following points:
 - a. Total enrollment is down a mere 30 FTE students, a decline perhaps due to tougher academic standards and a depressed economy.
 - b. Fort Campbell is "booming," operating at a profit.
 - c. Recent accreditation reports (education, nursing) have been favorable.
 - d. This year's promotion list is twice as large as last year's.
 - e. A second VAX computer is about to be acquired for administrative purposes.
 - f. Campus security provisions are being improved.
 - g. Faculty are urged to work on recruitment.
- 5. Remarks from President Carter:
 - a. Senate approved TuTh schedule will be in effect next year.
 - b. Distinguished Professor ballots are out; faculty are reminded to vote for five candidates.
- 6. Parking: Faculty White Committee recommends a \$5 parking fee.
- 7. Moved that the Faculty Senate recommends a \$5 parking fee for next year. Seconded and passed.
- 8. Faculty Review of Administration. Results are available from Senators, President, or from the Faculty Senate Secretary.

- 9. Reform of Registration Procedures: Referred to Academic Red Committee.
- 10. Merit Pay recommendations forthcoming.
- 11. Meeting adjourned for lack of quorum at 4:05 p.m.
