

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Montgomery County recorded 387 new cases in 10 days (9/2-9/12) for 12-18 year olds.
- Tennova reports 80 COVID patients, 39 of them housed in the ER because of bed shortage. O₂ concentrators for discharge are in short supply, meaning, they cannot discharge people because patients do not have the proper equipment and cannot get it.
- CMCSS reports 260 positive (87 are employees), 2633 in quarantine. The School Board has the mask issue on the agenda for tonight's meeting.
