The services of the University Student Health Services are available to currently enrolled full-time and part-time students of the University. Services are also available to faculty and staff for emergencies or emergency evaluation. The office is located in Ellington Hall with an outside entrance marked "Student Health Service." Entrance to the parking lot is from Drane Street.

Hours of Operation:

Monday - Tuesday, Thursday - Friday: 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. Wednesday: 7:30 a.m. - noon Saturday and Sunday: Closed

Limited emergency coverage is provided after hours. If medical treatment is needed when the Student Health Services is closed, head residents or the Department of Public Safety (648-7786) may be contacted to procure services of the Student Health Services Assistant and/or the Montgomery County Ambulance Service.

Emergencies:

Services:

- -Allergy injections (Student provide their own medication and instructions. Syringes are provided at a fee.)
- -Blood pressure checks
- -Simple urinalysis
- -Pregnancy testing
- -Various laboratory testing
- -Blood tests for marriage

- -Medication
- -Diagnosis and treatment of illness per established
- -Family planning (birth control counseling) -Patient teaching for preventative health
- -Health and Wellness Planning

There is no charge for the use of the Student Health Services or for services of medical personnel. Certain medications can be obtained at a reduced price.
