

Standing Committee Annual Report 2023-2024

Name of Committee or Council: Sustainable Campus Fee Committee

Meeting Dates in Current Year: First Tuesday of every month

Major Actions or Accomplishments:

- Kayla Miller-Zapata became the Chair of the Sustainable Campus Fee Committee in April of 2023. Meetings for the committee started in September of 2023. The meetings were held on the first Tuesday of every month.
- In January of 2024, the three student representative spots for the committee and Sodexo representative spots were filled.
- The members reviewed and updated the committee's bylaws in February 2024.
- The student winners of the Great Green Idea were announced in February 2024. The committee reviewed nine submissions in total.

The committee reviewed requests for sustainable fee funding and awarded \$73,000 in total for 2023-2024 projects. These projects include:

- Smart Irrigation System for Physical Plant
- AmeriCorps VISTA Environmental Stewardship position with the Office of Community Engagement and Sustainability
- Water Filling Station to be installed in the Music Mass Communication building

The committee reviewed requests for sustainable fee funding and is awaiting signature from the APSU Vice President to move forward with approved projects for 2024.

- LED Lighting Upgrade for the Department of Theater and Dance - \$14,500
- Water Filling Station to be installed in the McCord building - \$3,500
- Water Filling Station to be installed in the Kimbrough building - \$3,500
