Major Actions or Accomplishments:

- The APSU Peay Pickup will be rerouted in order to reach the outer lots of campus. The suggested route is from University Avenue to 4th Street, to Home Avenue proceeding to current internal circulation. This route will allow the shuttle to reach lots 27, 28, 29, and 30. It has been suggested that a bus station be placed near the outer lots.
- 10 parking spaces in lot 25 removed. The 10 spaces are immediately in front of the mural.
- Drane Street has become a right turn only onto College Street.
- A lot rental fee for the Clarksville community has been recommended. This fee will help with lot upkeep. For example, when the Arts Festival takes place and utilizes APSU's lots there has been no charge.
- Concern with the timing and sequencing of the traffic light on 9th Street heading South. The city has been contacted to see if they will assist with this safety issue.
- New parking software will be implemented beginning Fall 2022. One vanity plate will be given at no cost to each student/faculty/staff who are interested in receiving one (beginning Fall 2022).
